★ To begin a new search after each question below, click appropriate tab across top of database screen

1. A student needs a general definition and summary for the condition Angina.

- Click *Medical Encyclopedia*
- Scroll down*
- Click *arrow* to view next page
- Click *angina*

2. A patron wants a list of hospitals and other health care facilities with the word Palmetto in their name in South Carolina?

- Click *Health Organizations Directory*
- Type 'Palmetto' in the search term in the box
- Click the check box marked *Hospitals and health care facilities, programs and special care*
- Click the arrow next to the drop down box named *State or Province* and choose 'South Carolina'
- Click the *search* button next to the search term box

3. A patron needs the generic name for Demerol.

- Click *Drug & Herb Finder*
- Type 'Demerol' in the *Search for* box at the top of the page
- Click *Search*
- Browse through the articles until the generic name is mentioned
